HOW SURVEY WAS SHARED



June 3rd

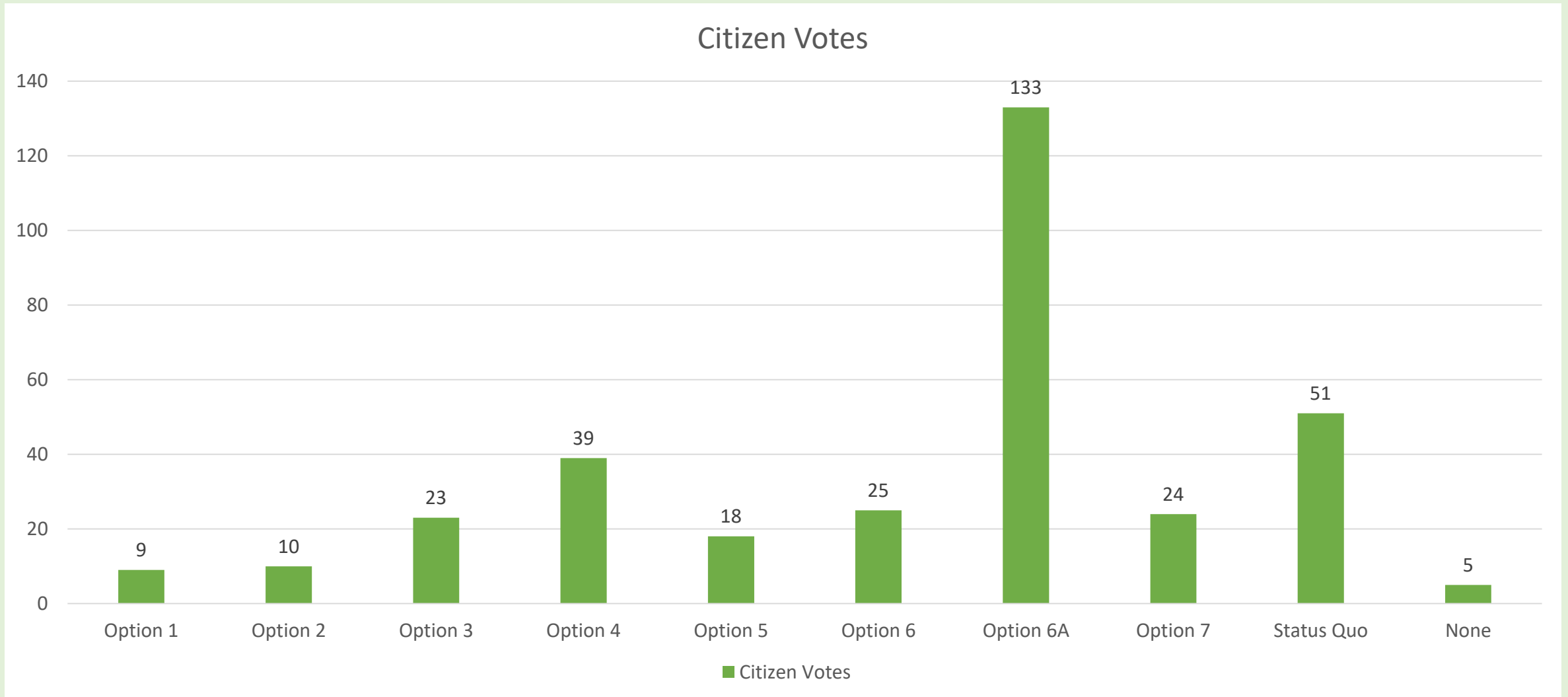
- Survey was placed on the district website.
- An email was sent to all district staff.
- An email was sent to all student families.
- An email was sent to all board members and CAC committee members.
- A post was placed on the district Facebook page regarding the survey. That post was shared 31 times.

June 6th

- An email was sent to all student families reminding them that the survey was going to close.
- A post was placed on the district Facebook page.

THEMES FROM THE DATA

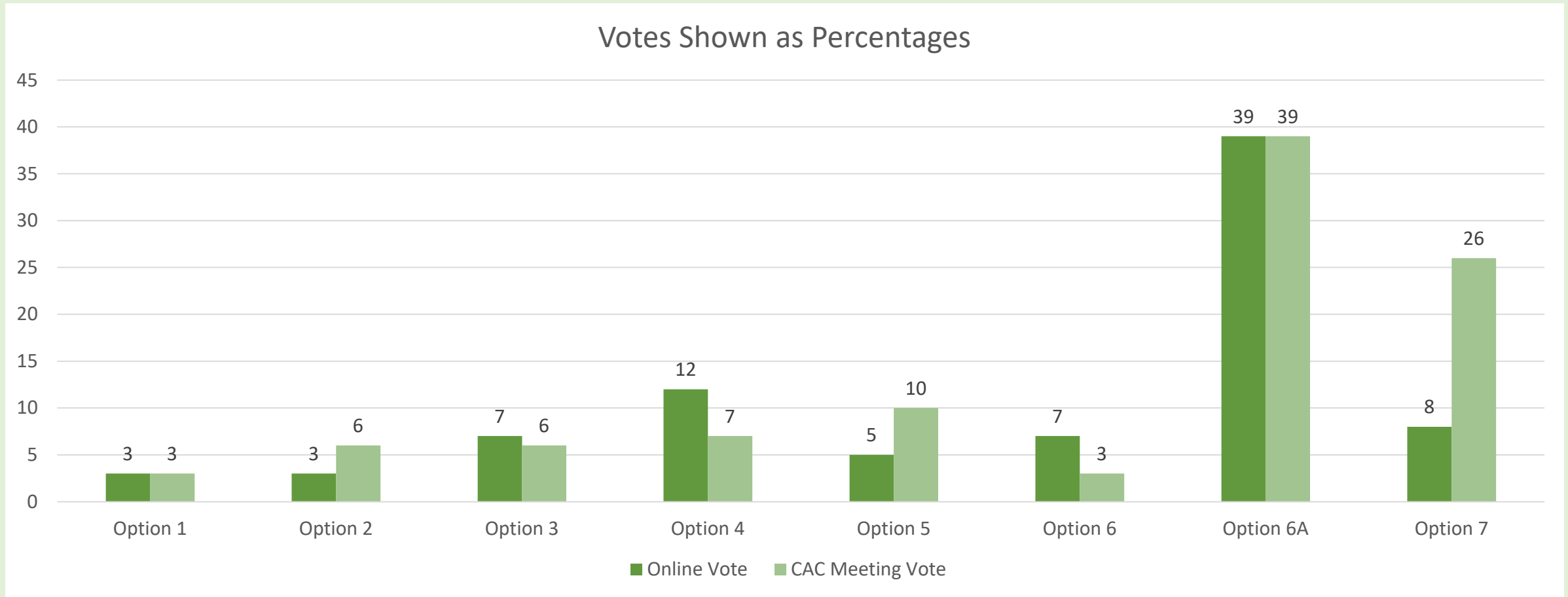


Total respondents = 337

- In regards to Northwestern, **5.7%** (19 votes) of respondents voted for an option that included opening Northwestern. (Option 1 and 2)
- In regards to Patterson, **26.1%** of respondents voted for an option that included Patterson remaining open. (Option 1, 2, 5 and Status Quo)
- When looking at all of the votes with the exception of None of the Above, **2.7%** of respondents support 5 campuses. **23.4%** support 4 campuses. **60.8%** support 3 campuses. **11.6%** support 2 campuses.
- **79.8%** voted for an option that involved major changes to existing facilities. **15.1%** of people voted to remain status quo.
- The most popular grade configuration for our youngest learners is K-5 with **60.9%** of the vote



COMPARISON OF CAC MEETING VOTES AND ONLINE VOTES



The option of Status Quo and None were not included in the survey for CAC meeting.
On the online survey, Status Quo represented 15%. None represented 1%.
Survey at CAC meeting allowed respondents to vote for 3 options.
