Capital Project Updates, by Tom Durkin, VEBH, Architect

- 1. Accessibility Review of HS and PPS
  - a. VEBH is reviewing options for the District; reviewed initial thoughts at this meeting but stated the need for more time and owner input
- 2. PPS Kitchen design
  - a. On schedule; bidding in April with awarding of bids scheduled for May
- 3. High School and BIS Site Plan: VEBH status

\*6.2 Approval is recommended for Construction Engineering Consultants (CEC) for subsurface investigations required for storm water management design as required by Chippewa Township for the projects and amounts as listed:

- a. HMS, Renovation Project \$3,180
- b. BIS, Concrete and Pavement Project \$1,375
- c. BHS, Concrete and Pavement Project \$1,375

\*6.3 Approval is recommended for Widmer Engineering to provide additional engineering services related to identifying existing conditions of underground storm piping for the BIS pavement project at a cost not to exceed of \$2,000.

- 4. NWPS Window replacement design
  - a. Doors were included in this design; the Board asked for these to be bid as alternates due to the increase in the project's cost
- 5. Change Orders:

6.1 The Architect is requesting that the District authorize a Change Order to Ceriani Construction in the amount of \$695.36 to replace the Gym's interior door number G12 which was damaged beyond repair. The manufacturer reported that the warranty would not cover its replacement because the type of damage (abuse) was outside the warranty coverage.
