Grades 5-8 will begin virtually for a minimum of two weeks from September 8 through September 18. Grades 9-12 will begin virtually for a minimum of 4 weeks from September 8 through October 2. If the pending county data remains at the moderate level, and there have been no reported cases requiring the closure of any school buildings or activities, the high school would potentially begin a Hybrid Model on Monday, October 5.
