Summary of Gifted Evaluation Regarding Cognitive Functioning and Multiple Criteria

Student: Grade:
Cognitive Functioning
Individually-administered Full Scale intelligence test score:
 Student has 130 or higher Full Scale IQ Student has 125-129 Full Scale IQ and meets all multiple criteria Student has an IQ score of 125 or above on both verbal and nonverbal domains and meets all multiple criteria Student has 120-124 Full Scale IQ and exceeds all multiple criteria Student does not meet any of the above
Multiple Criteria
1. Achievement (must meet 3 out of 4 criteria)
 One grade level above on standardized achievement test ≥50th percentile Performance on at least one measure of individualized standardized achievement tests ≥95th percentile Advanced on any PSSA area/Elementary BAS one grade level above Grades are at least 95% in at least 3/5 core academic classes
2. Rates of Acquisition and Retention
90% or above on Acquisition and Retention scale
3. Achievement, Performance, or Expertise
SIGS results- 130 or higher on 3 or more scales
Student meets 2 of 3 Multiple Criteria
