- Assist with the cost of trade school or college (Approved Governors List Preference)

Who qualifies?

Age 14-18

- MUST BE attending school
- MUST BE a Beaver County resident
- Low Income no barriers required

And / OR

• Disability (will be considered a family size of ONE (1). Must meet income requirements for family size of ONE (1).

Age 19-21

Must be all of the above <u>excluding disability</u>

AND/ OR must meet **one** of the following:

- Basic skills deficient
- English language learner
- An offender
- Homeless
- Runaway
- In foster care or aged out of foster care system
- Pregnant or parenting (custody of child)
- Disability (will be considered a family size of ONE (1). Must meet income requirements for family size of ONE (1).

<u>Must meet with JTBC staff and, supply birth certificate, social security card, and parent signatures if under 18 (More documentation may be needed, it will be discussed during the meeting)</u>
