Repository of Unsold Properties

- 1. The minimum bid acceptable to the Tax Claim Bureau will be the record costs as they appear on the dockets of each individual parcel in the Repository of Unsold Properties.
- 2. Pursuant to sections 627 of the Pennsylvania Real Estate Tax Sale Law, affected taxing authorities must give written consent to the sale of any property held in the Repository of Unsold Property.

 - (iii) has not, within the three years preceding the filing of the application, engaged in a course of conduct or permitted an uncorrected housing code violation, as defined in section 619(e), to continue unabated after being convicted of an uncorrected housing code violation, as defined in section 619(e), and has not either:
 - (A) failed to maintain property owned by the applicant in a reasonable manner such that the property posed a threat to health, safety or property; or
 - (B) permitted the use of property in an unsafe, illegal or unsanitary manner such that the property posed a threat to health, safety or property; and
 - (iv) understands that an applicant who signs a bidder registration application knowing that it contains a false statement and who causes it to be filed with the bureau shall be subject to prosecution for the commission of a misdemeanor of the second degree in violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904(a) (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

THIEL COLLEGEAFFILIATION AGREEMENT FOR USE OF A AUDIOLOGY/SPEECH PATHOLOGY CLINICAL SITE

THIS AGREEMENT, is made and entered into as of August 14, 2023 by and between THIEL COLLEGE, (hereinafter referred to as "College"), a private educational institution and BLACKHAWK AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT (hereinafter "Site"), Federal Identification (EIN) number

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, Site is equipped with the facilities and professional staff necessary to provide an educational experience to the College's students in the area of Master of Science in Speech Pathology; and WHEREAS, the College is an educational institution that provides a degree in the area of speech pathology; and

WHEREAS, the College is desirous of providing an educational experience to its students limited to participation through supervision in a clinic setting; and

WHEREAS, the Site is desirous of establishing a relationship with the College whereby its students may receive clinical experience in their area of matriculation subject to the provisions of this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, intending to be legally bound, the parties hereto agree as follows:

I. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COLLEGE

- a. Selection of Students. The College shall be responsible for the selection of qualified students to participate in the clinical experience. Selected students must have the appropriate educational background and skills consistent with the contemplated educational experience offered by the Site. The parties will mutually agree upon the number of students selected for each clinical program.
- b. *Education of Students*. The College shall assume full responsibility for the classroom education of its students. The College shall be responsible for the administration of the program, the curriculum content, the requirements of matriculation, grading, graduation and faculty appointments.
- c. Submission of Candidates. The College shall submit the names of the students to a designated representative of the Site at least two weeks prior to the clinical assignment.
- d. *Policies of Clinic*. The College will review with each student, prior to the clinical assignment any and all applicable policies, codes, or confidentiality issues related to the clinic experience. The Site will provide the College all the applicable information at least two weeks in advance of the clinical rotation.
- e. Advising Students of Rights and Responsibilities. The College will be responsible for advising students of their responsibilities under this Agreement and for informing Site should College become aware that any student is not abiding by their responsibilities or the policies of the Site. All students shall be advised of their obligations to abide by the policies and procedures of the Site and should any student fail to abide by any policy and/or procedure, they may be expelled from the program.
- f. Health Status. The College will require its students who are participating in the clinical experience to comply with the health status requirements of the Site, including but not limited to, physical examinations, vaccinations and health screening requirements for tuberculosis and measles. Proof of compliance must be presented prior to admission into the program. If additional examinations or medical steps are required because of the nature of the clinic involved, the student will be in compliance as a condition for participation. g. Scheduling of Site. The College shall plan the assignment and schedules of those participating in the clinical experience in cooperation with the Site.
- h. Professional Liability Insurance. The College shall maintain professional liability coverage covering students in practicum with limits of \$1M per claim/\$3M Aggregate during the clinical assignment.

II. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SITE

- a. Student Participation in Site. The Site will inform College which of its provider locations will be able to provide a clinical experience and the number of students that may be accommodated at each location. The Site agrees that the students selected for the program will be permitted to participate at dates and times mutually agreeable between the Site and the College.
- b. Patient Care/Administration. The Site will have sole authority and control over all aspects of patient services. The Site will be responsible for and retain control over the organization, operation and financing of its services.
- c. Removal of Noncompliant Student. The Site shall have the authority to immediately remove a student who fails to comply with Site policies and procedures or whose actions pose a risk to the health or safety of patients or who are disruptive to Site's operations. If such a removal occurs, the Site should immediately contact the responsible College Clinical Director.
- d. *Emergency Medical Care of Students*. The Site may provide to the Students, to the extent possible, first aid for any injuries or illness that may occur during a clinical experience. However, the Site assumes no responsibility, financial or otherwise, beyond the initial first aid, except for injuries resulting from the Site's negligence.
- e. Designation of Representative. The Site shall designate a person to serve as a liaison between the parties who will meet periodically with representatives of the College in order to discuss, plan and evaluate the clinical experiences of the students.
- f. Supervision of Students. The Site shall assume responsibility for the supervision of students and provide clinical site supervisors who will monitor student activities during clinical visits.
- g. Reporting of Student Progress. The Site shall provide all reasonable information requested by the College on a student's work performance. If there are any student evaluations, they will be completed and returned according to any reasonable schedule provided by the College.
- h. Changes in Assignment. The Site will, as soon as practical, advise the College of any changes in clinical assignments. If additional clinical education programs exist with other institutions, the Site shall devise ways for the coordination of all programs so that all students may have the maximum benefit of the learning experience.
- i. Rules and Policies. The Site will provide the College, at least two weeks in advance of the first clinical rotation, all relevant rules, regulations and policies of the Site. The Site, when necessary, shall have the responsibility of updating this information as necessary.



j. Facilities. Available space at the Site, as specified by the Site, will be established by mutual agreement and made accessible to the College faculty and students for instruction, conferences and library purposes. k. Student Records. The Site shall protect the confidentiality of student records as dictated by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and shall release no information absent written consent of the student unless required to do so by law or as dictated by the terms of this Agreement.

III. MUTUAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a. Term of Agreement. The term of this Agreement shall be five years from the date of execution. This Agreement may not exceed a period of five years.
- b. Termination of Agreement. The College or the Site may terminate this Agreement for any reason with ninety (90) days written notice. Either party may terminate this Agreement in the event of a substantial breach. However, should the Site terminate this Agreement prior to the completion of an academic semester, all students enrolled at that time may continue their educational experience until it would have been concluded absent the termination.
- c. Nondiscrimination. The parties agree to continue their respective policies of nondiscrimination based on Title VI of the Civil rights Act of 1964 in regard to sex, age, race, color, creed, national origin. Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and other applicable laws, as well as the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). College students are protected by Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and other applicable laws, as well as the provisions of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (as amended) and the ADA. Site agrees to cooperate with the College in its investigation of claims of discrimination or harassment.
- d. Reporting of Sexual Violence and Sexual Harassment: Site shall report any incident in which a student is the victim of sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, stalking or sexual harassment to the College Title IX Coordinator, Ms. Jennifer Clark, at 724.589.2858.
- e. Interpretation of the Agreement. The laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall govern this Agreement.
- f. Modification of Agreement. This Agreement shall only be modified in writing with the same formality as the original Agreement.

g. Relationship of Parties. The relationship between the parties to this Agreement to each other is that of independent contractors. The relationship of the parties to this contract to each other shall not be construed to constitute a partnership, joint venture or any other relationship, other than that of independent contractors. h. Liability. Neither of the parties shall assume any liabilities to each other. As to liability to each other or death to persons, or damages to property, the parties do not waive any defenses as a result of entering into this contract. This provision shall not be construed to limit the College's rights, claims or defenses which arise as a matter of law pursuant to any provisions of this contract. This provision shall not be construed to limit the sovereign immunity of the Commonwealth.

i. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the parties. No other prior or contemporaneous oral or written understandings or promises exist in regards to this relationship.
