RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS OF THE BLACKHAWK SCHOOL DISTRICT, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO NOT INCREASE ITS TAX RATE ABOVE THE INDEX FOR THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

Whereas, Act 1 of Special Session of 2006 requires school districts to adopt a preliminary budget proposal no later than 90 days prior to the date of the election immediately preceding the fiscal year in which the preliminary budget will take effect; and

Whereas, Act 1 of Special Session of 2006 further provides that a board of school directors may elect to adopt a resolution no later than 110 days prior to the date of the election immediately preceding the upcoming fiscal year indicating that it will not raise the rate of any tax for the support of its public schools for the following fiscal year by more than the index; and

Whereas, The Board of School Directors of the Blackhawk School District desires to keep all proposed tax increases for the 2024-2025 school year within its index to provide the necessary revenue to meet the proposed expenditures for the 2024-2025 school year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Act 1 of Special Session 2006, the Blackhawk School District hereby certifies that it shall not increase any tax used for the support of the school district by a rate greater than the index of 5.1 percent for Beaver County and 7.1 percent for Lawrnce County established by the Pennsylvania Department of Education for the fiscal year 2024-2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. That the Board will not increase any School District tax for the 2024-2025 school year at a rate that exceeds the index as calculated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education.
- 2. That the Board will comply with the procedures set forth in Section 687 of the Pennsylvania Public School Code (hereinafter "School Code"), 24 P.S. §6-687, for the adoption of its proposed and final budget.
- 3. hat the Board certifies that increasing any tax at a rate less than or equal to the index will be sufficient to balance its final budget of the 2024-2025 fiscal year.
- 4. That the Administration of the District will submit the District's information on a proposed increase in the rate of a tax levied for the support of the District to the Pennsylvania Department of Education on the uniform form prepared by the Pennsylvania Department of Education no later than five (5) days after the Board's adoption of this Resolution.

5. That the Administration of the District will send a copy of this Resolution to the Pennsylvania Department of Education no later than five (5) days after the Board's adoption of this Resolution.
6. That the Board understands and agrees that by adopting this Resolution it is not eligible to seek referendum exceptions under Section 333(f) of Act 1 and is not eligible to request approval form the voters through a referendum to increase a tax rate by more than the index as established for the 2024-2025 fiscal year.
7. That once this Resolution is adopted, the Administration of the District is not required to comply with the preliminary budget requirements set forth in Paragraphs (a) and (c) of Section 311 of Act 1. Provided however:
a. The Board understands and agrees that, upon receipt of the information submitted by the District as set forth in Paragraphs 4 and 5 above, the Pennsylvania Department of Education shall compare the District's proposed percentage increase in the rate of the tax with the index.
b. Within ten (10) days of the receipt of this information, the Pennsylvania Department of Education shall inform the District whether its proposed tax rate increase is less than or equal to the index.
c. If the Pennsylvania Department of Education determines that the District's proposed increase in the rate of the District's tax exceeds the index, the District is subject to the preliminary budget requirements as set forth in Paragraphs (a) and (c) of Section 311 of Act 1.

LETTER OF AGREEMENT Between BLACKHAWK SCHOOL DISTRICT and BEAVER VALLEY INTERMEDIATE UNIT 27

Title I Nonpublic Programs and Services

This agreement is made and entered into as of the of 2023, by and between Blackhawk School District (hereinafter referred to as the "School District") and the **BEAVER VALLEY INTERMEDIATE UNIT, BVIU.**

1. TERM

The Term of this Agreement shall be for one year, beginning on July 1, 2023, and ending on June 30, 2024 the "Initial Term"). Upon mutual agreement of the Parties, this Agreement may be extended beyond the Initial Term for two successive terms of one year each from July 1st to June 30th of the applicable year (each a "Renewal Term"). Unless extended for one of the two available Renewal Terms, this Agreement shall expire automatically at the conclusion of the Initial Term or Renewal Term then in effect. Notwithstanding the foregoing or any other provision of this Agreement, either Party may terminate this Agreement at any time, with or without cause, upon providing the other Party thirty (30) days prior written notice.

2. DESCRIPTION

Upon the terms and conditions set forth herein, School District requests that the BVIU provide secular, neutral, non-ideological remedial reading instructional services as articulated in the school district's request for assistance and in accordance with the school district's consolidated application for a Title I Reading Program for academically-eligible students at the nonpublic school(s) listed in section 3.1.

Selection of students is determined through multiple criteria, including but not limited to standardized assessment scores, parent/teacher referrals, and informal assessments. Barring scheduling interruptions, students will receive services a minimum of twice per week at a session length as requested by each individual school, typically 30 – 40 minutes. The provision of services is subject to availability of staff. The BVIU will provide a list of students in October and will verify any new referrals with School District throughout the year.

DIBELS, AIMSWEB and CORE assessments will be given during September, January, and April as applicable. Performance data will be sent to School District at the completion of the school year or upon request. The BVIU will provide a template Performance Goal that School District may choose to use for eGrants reporting.

The School District and the BVIU agree to pool funds for instruction in the private schools. The pooled funds are used to serve the private school students most at risk who reside in participating public school attendance areas regardless of the amount of funds that was generated based on the number of children from low-income families attending that private school.

3. FEES AND PAYMENT

3.1 In consideration of the services mutually agreed upon as described herein, School District shall pay the BVIU 6% of the total per-pupil allocation in Administrative Costs and a rate of \$75.00 per student hour for Non-Public Title I Instructional Services but in total not to exceed a sum equal to the district's annual nonpublic school set aside as determined by their per-pupil allocation times the number of low-income private school children. The total allocation is itemized in the table below and is subject to change per Title I reallocation as described in section 3.4.

- 3.2 The BVIU shall invoice the School District for the total amount in May 2023. Payment must be received by the BVIU by June 15, 2023.
- The School District and the BVIU acknowledge that in the event that there are no eligible students in the program, the BVIU will not invoice the School District until and unless a student is identified.
- 3.4 The School District and the BVIU acknowledge that final allocations may not be available until after March 1st and that an increase or decrease in funds may increase or decrease the services outlined in this Agreement. Changes would occur with consultation between the School District and the BVIU.

4. BEAVER VALLEY INTERMEDIATE UNIT RESPONSIBILITES:

- 4.1 To provide instructional services by a certified reading specialist, as required by Title I.
- 4.2 To use appropriate evaluative testing/screening procedures and materials.
- 4.3 To follow the School District local assessment plan for Title I students whenever possible.
- 4.4 To provide small group supplemental reading instruction for eligible private school students.
- 4.5 To assure all financial and legal responsibilities involved in providing the instruction:
 - 4.5.1 Pay salary and all benefits for the reading specialist
 - 4.5.2 Provide reading materials, which supplement regular instruction
 - 4.5.3 Provide diagnostic testing instruments
 - 4.5.4 Supervise the instruction
 - 4.5.5 Any other responsibilities necessary to conduct the program as intended including scheduling of students, providing professional development for BVIU teachers, parental permission process, establish performance goals in consultation with NPS, annual program evaluation, evaluation of instructional staff, NPS visitation, annual assessment plan review, annual complaint procedure review, and coordination with ACT 89 Program.
- 4.6 To require the BVIU teacher to complete the following requirements in addition to providing the weekly instructional periods:
 - 4.6.1 Conduct diagnostic and benchmark testing as needed on eligible students
 - 4.6.2 Maintain records of assessment data, instructional activities, and attendance for students
 - 4.6.3 Meet with parents for conferences as requested
 - 4.6.4 Provide benchmark reports at the beginning, middle and end of the year for each student served
- 4.7 To be responsible for the following:
 - 4.7.1 Provide the School District with the addresses of the students served
 - 4.7.2 Provide the School District with the data necessary to complete their Title I responsibilities including assessment data and related data.
 - 4.7.3 Meet with private school administrators a minimum of once a year to review services provided to their students
 - 4.7.4 Provide the School District access to the program at any time
 - 4.7.5 Family Engagement activities including: Parental Advisory Council (PAC) Annual Meeting, NP School Title 1
 Family Engagement Policy, School/Parent Compacts (for school, parent and student), Family Conferences,
 Family Engagement Workshops, Annual Family Engagement Survey

5. SCHOOL DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 5.1 Provide the BVIU with names of private schools identified to participate in Title I.
- 5.2 Assist the BVIU in identifying addresses of students who reside in Title I attendance areas.
- 5.3 Inform the Beaver Valley Intermediate Unit of any and all circumstances which may directly or indirectly affect the performance of this Agreement, including changes in the original funding allocation.
- 5.4 The School District assures BVIU that all meaningful consultation between the School District and the abovenamed private school(s) is completely in accordance with current regulations.
- 5.5 The School District will develop and provide a written procedure for resolving complaints in accordance with current regulations.

6. MISCELLANEOUS

- 6.1 The Beaver Valley Intermediate Unit maintains and keeps in force such insurance as Workers Compensation, Liability, and Property Damage.
- 6.2 The Beaver Valley Intermediate Unit shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the School District from any and all losses, damages, claims or costs, including attorney's fees, arising from any act or omission of the BVIU, its officials, agents, or employees.

6.3 The School District and BVIU acknowledge that it may be necessary to modify this Agreement if there is a reauthorization of ESSA during the performance period of the contract. Periodic operational revisions not directly impacting the terms spelled out in this agreement will be articulated in revisions of Section 3.1.

7. TERMINATION

- 7.1 This Agreement may be terminated for convenience by the School District only if all eligible students are dismissed from the program, in which case the School District shall pay the BVIU in accordance with Section 3.3, above.
- 7.2 This Agreement may be terminated for cause by either party in the event of a material breach by the other party following 30 days' written notice of such breach and intent to terminate, provided the breaching party fails to cure such breach. In the event of termination for cause, the BVIU shall cease providing services as of the termination date, and the School District shall be liable for services rendered through the termination date.
