During the daylong session, they used the Pathway's rubric to assess their own school's or district's, current performance in six areas: teacher qualifications, curriculum, instructional practices, assessment and demonstration of skills, family engagement, and real-world connections. After self-assessment on each criterion, participants selected up to three areas to prioritize and then worked on a timeline and an action plan to address those goals. Through periodic reassessment and repetition of this process, schools and districts can progress to higher levels of STEM education excellence. This cycle is beneficial to all regardless of their current STEM offerings.
